

Entry:

Information on how to enter and other details form part of these terms & conditions. To the extent of any inconsistency in the information on how to enter and any other details and instructions, these terms & conditions prevail.

- Entry can be completed online from 2 May to 3pm, 27 May 2022.
- This is a photographic competition and each entrant can submit up to five (5) images which should include at least one full length shot and a close-up of a chosen aspect of their outfit's details.
- Note: Please ensure your images are high resolution
 - Images can be taken inside, outside or in both settings
 - It is at the entrant's discretion as to who takes their photos & optional video for them
 - Each entry must submit a minimum of one (1) - and no more than five (5) - images
- Entrants may also submit one (1) 15 sec video should they wish
- Contestants must be at least 18 years of age and residing in New Zealand
